Dear Parents/Guardians,

I want to make you aware of a change to the instructional schedule for the week of November 2nd. Governor Murphy's Executive Order #177 requires all public schools in New Jersey to be closed on Election Day, November 3rd, for in-building instruction. The day can be used for virtual instruction; therefore, Lincoln Park will have a virtual instruction day on November 3rd. On Thursday and Friday of that week the schools are closed for in-building and virtual instruction due to the New Jersey Education Association's Teacher Convention. The school schedule has been modified for the week of November 2nd as follows:

Monday, Nov. 2nd – A Cohort/Red Group – in-building instruction

Tuesday, Nov. 3rd – Virtual Instruction for Entire District


Wednesday, Nov. 4th – B Cohort/Blue Group – in-building instruction

Thursday & Friday, Nov. 5th & 6th – Teacher Convention – schools closed for all instruction

The decision to move the B Cohort's in-building instructional day to Wednesday was made for two reasons. First, it will allow each cohort at least one in-building instruction day that week. Secondly, the week of November 2nd is the first week for the sixth and seventh grade hybrid cohorts to return to the LPMS for in-building instruction. This will allow both cohorts an opportunity to return to the LPMS for instruction.

I recognize any change in the schedules can be difficult for many of you, but please understand, Executive Order #177 does not give us the option to open the buildings on Election Day, thereby requiring the change. Once again I thank you for your understanding and flexibility during these difficult times.
